- ◆ Stated explicitly, each of us has our own particular, individual Divine Mother.

transforms Herself into the fiery serpent.


"I am saying that we should love the Divine Mother. This God-mother is within us, not outside of us. She is, I repeat, a variant of our own Being but (I clarify) derived.





Deví Prayer


