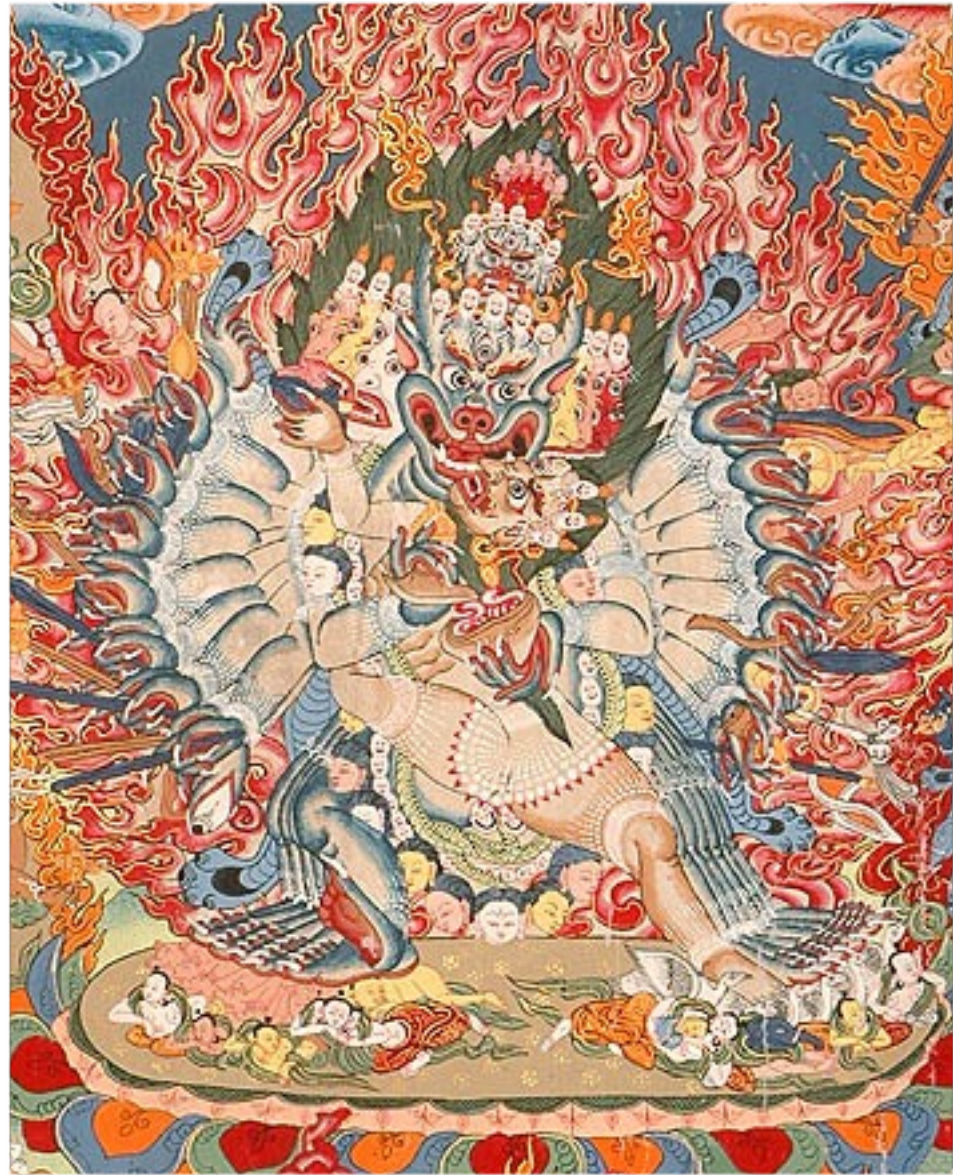

Stages of Death

- ✿ **Discovery:** when the ego has been seen in action, in manifestation.

- ✿ **Execution:** with the help of the Divine Mother Kundalini, through the wise practice of Sexual Super-dynamics, the ego is eliminated.

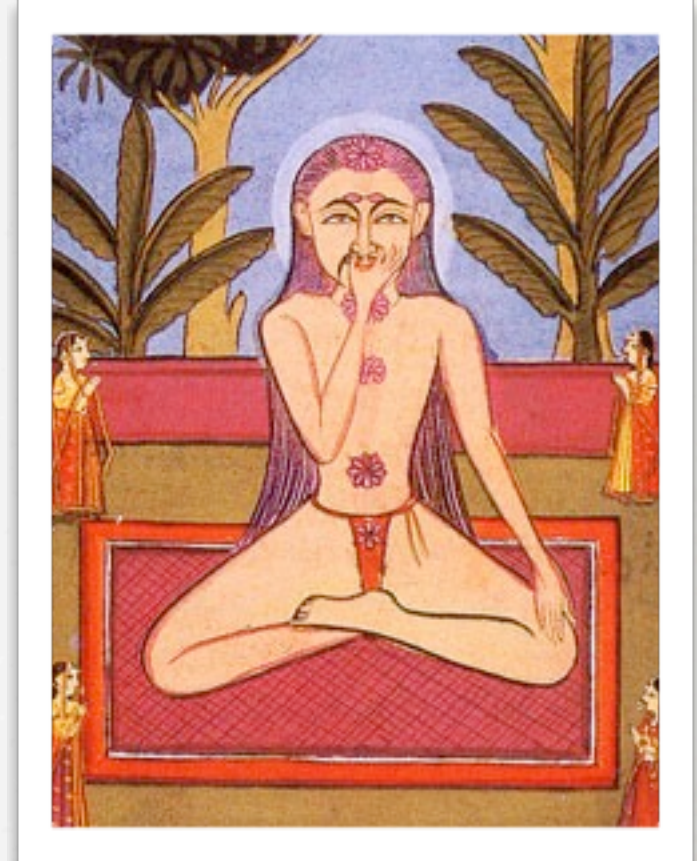

And **ayama**: “restraining, stretching, stopping, extending, breadth, length”





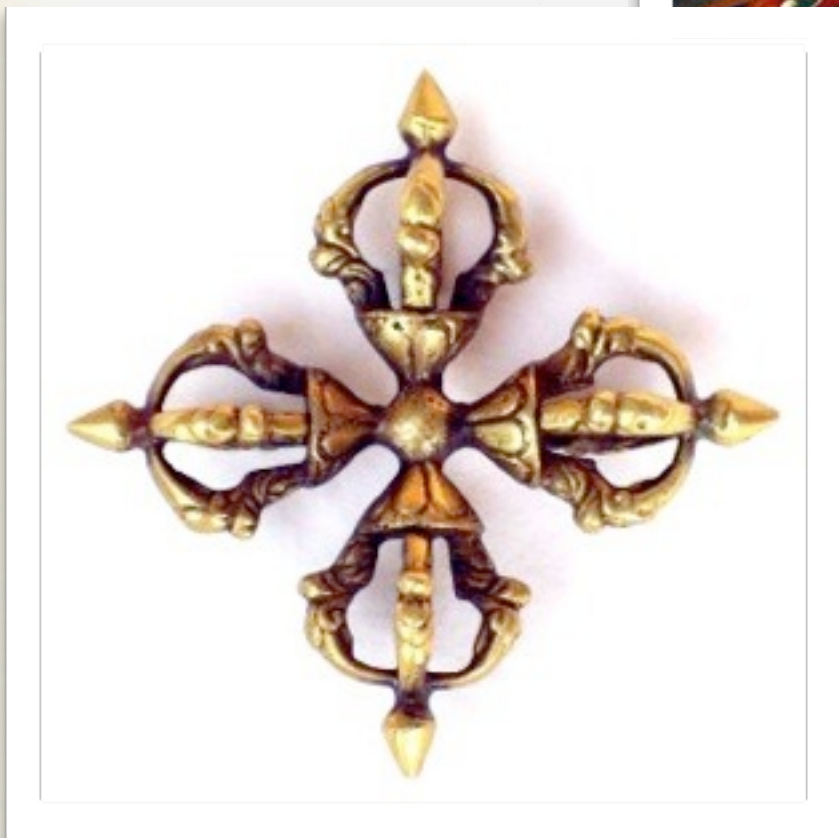
