



- In [Beresheeth] the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- These [Archetypes] were in the beginning with God.

Thou art the Lord who is commemorated in Maati, the Hidden Soul, the Lord of Qerrt, the Ruler supreme in White Wall (Memphis). Thou art the Soul of Ra, his own body, and hast thy place of rest in Henensu (Herakleopolis).

Thou art the beneficent one, and art praised in Nart. Thou makest thy soul to be raised up. Thou art the Lord of the Great House in Khemenu (Hermopolis). Thou art the mighty one of victories in Shas-hetep, the Lord of eternity, the Governor of Abtu (Abydos).

3- and the Triad of our Internal Being Samael Aun Weor




