



#### John 5

After this there was a feast of the Jews, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem (ירושלים, "foundation of peace"].

<sup>2</sup> Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, which is called in Hebrew, Bethesda [Bηθζαθά, Bēthzatha, "House of Mercy"], having five porches.

<sup>3</sup> In these lay a great multitude of sick people, blind, lame, paralyzed, waiting for the moving of the water.

<sup>4</sup> For an angel [ἄγγελος, aggelos, "messenger"] went down at a certain time into the pool and stirred [ταράσσω, tarassó, "troubled" or "disturbed"] up the water; then whoever stepped in first, after the stirring of the water, was made well of whatever disease he had.

<sup>5</sup> Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity [ἀσθένεια, astheneia, 'without strength'] thirty-eight years.

<sup>6</sup> When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, "Do you want to be made well?"

<sup>7</sup> The sick man answered Him, "Sir, I have no man [ἄνθρωπος, anthropos] to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up [ταράσσω, tarassó, "troubled" or "disturbed"]; but while I am coming, another steps down before me."

<sup>8</sup> Jesus said to him, "Rise, take up your bed and walk." <sup>9</sup> And immediately the man was made well, took up his bed, and walked.

And that day was the Sabbath [day of rest, \ zayin, 7].

<sup>10</sup> The Jews therefore said to him who was cured, "It is the Sabbath; it is not lawful for you to carry your bed."

Mem related to values 40 and 4. Symbolizes 'water.'

Mem is the creative waters from which all creative things emerge. The letter of the Holy Spirit (Binah).

Mem has a final or *sophit* form:


D. It represents the closed, the esoteric, the hidden wisdom in the Ain Soph.



1 Vav is the word 'and.' 1 Vav is the connector or bridge between ideas.

1 Vav is the conduit between man and God, between Heaven and Earth.

1 Vav is the vertical staff of the wise, the spinal column, the reed, the measure of wisdom.

בראשית ברא אלהים את השמים ואת הארץ Genesis 1:1 Tayin is similar to the letter 1 Vav. The only difference in shape between the letters 1 Zayin and 1 Vav is where the vertical line protrudes from the Iod.



Seventh Letter

**Zayin** means sword. It is also associated with the tongue. The tongue is a two-edged sword. The sword is carried by the hero.

Samech is similar to □ Mem final, representing the Infinite Waters (□) of Manifestation.


#### Five Porches or Pools
